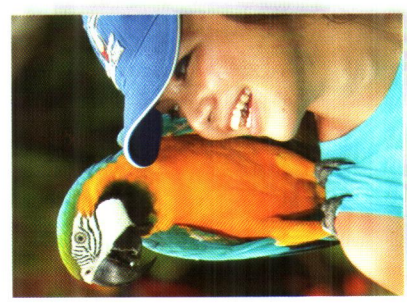

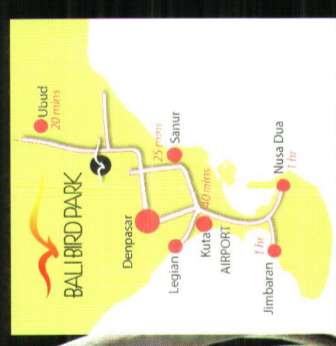

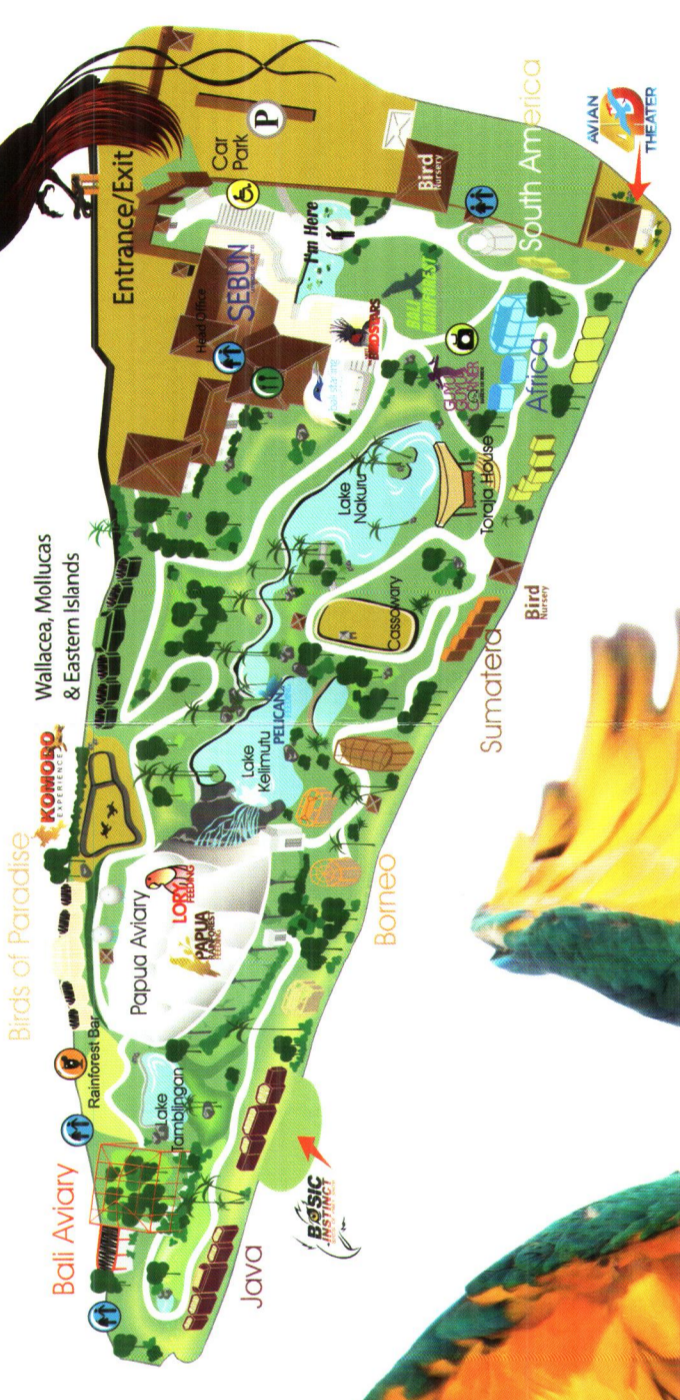

The park is divided into seven regions that recreate the natural habitats of our birds, complete with indigenous plant life.



You can travel from the deep misty jungle of Sumatra to far-east Indonesia and Papua to discover the native birds from these remote regions.

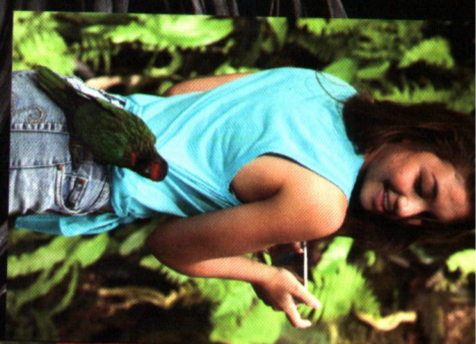


Meet the birds in our walk-in aviaries that resemble a tropical rainforest. Get up close and personal with magnificent macaws and majestic birds of prey.

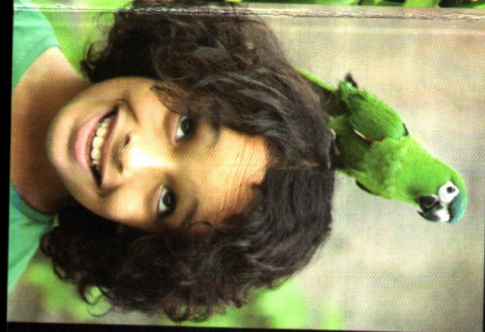


Be amazed by some of Indonesia's rarest birds, including the beautiful Bali Starling and our exotic Bird of Paradise - one of the largest collections in the world.

At the Bali Bird Park you can interact with our birds. Come feed the colorful lories, meet our bird stars including our world - famous Black Palm Cockatoo Anna-Maria or mingle with the birds that meander through the park.



Be amazed at how close you can get to our feathered residents.



At the Guyu-Guyu Corner our spectacular macaws and colorful cockatoos will perch on your shoulder for a photo opportunity. Come meet the impressive wreathed hornbills. The male's throat pouch is yellow, the female's is blue, and they mate for life.



Be amazed at the Eclectus parrot couple. For this colorful pair, the male is bright emerald green and his mate is scarlet red. You'll find them curious and friendly and perfect for a shot to show everyone back home.



You can take a walk on the wild side too. Admire our resident Komodo dragon, a giant monitor lizard that is a direct descendant of the dinosaurs that lived nearly a 100 million years ago.



And let your imagination fly when you meet our majestic birds of prey - from eagles to kites, owls to falcons. Watch them as they soar overhead and swoop down at the Basic Instinct show. Look out for the South East Asian Barred Eagle Owl. You'll recognize him by his large, sideways - pointing ear tufts and powerful talons.



Join us for an adventure that knows no boundaries. It's a day out that you will remember forever.

We are home to the largest and finest collection of Indonesian birds in the world.



We have also made room for their exotic cousins from Africa, South America and Australia.

Follow our graceful African Crowned Crane as they wander around the park, often with their chicks in tow - just one example of our successful breeding program.



Check out the chicks in the nursery, and learn how the Bali Bird Park is committed to the preservation of bird life.
