

Mandiri donates garbage trucks to city

State-owned lender Bank Mandiri, represented by president director Budi Gunadi Sadikin, has donated three garbage trucks to the Jakarta administration, represented by Deputy Governor Basuki “Ahok” Tjahaja Purnama.

Budi said that he hoped the donation would be useful for both residents and the city administration.

“We wanted to donate something that would help residents. Hopefully the garbage trucks will help ease waste management systems in Jakarta,” Budi told reporters at City Hall on Monday.
